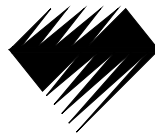

Title: Certification, German Import Requirements

1. **ATA Code:** Not Applicable
2. **Effectivity:** All DA 20 Katanas, S/N 10002 and subsequent, for operation under German registry.
3. **General:** This bulletin describes modifications and equipment required for aircraft operation under German registry.
4. **Compliance:** Prior to issue of LBA Certificate of Airworthiness.
5. **Approval:** Data referenced or contained in this bulletin is LBA approved.
6. **Labor:** 2 Man-hours.
7. **Material:** German Placards (in accordance with Doc. No. DA202-D), Fuel Pipette (ref. P/N 20-1200-02-00).
8. **Special Tools:** None
9. **References:** Flight Manual Doc. No. DA202-D, LBA Type Certificate 1099.

10. Accomplishment Instructions:

10.1 Placards

- 10.1.1 All German language placards must be installed in place of original English placards, as per the Flight Manual, Doc. No. DA202-D, Section 2-15.

10.2 Fireproof Data Placard

- 10.2.1 Data Plate (ref. P/N 20-1120-01-12) must be engraved or stamped with the aircraft Serial Number, the year of manufacture and German registration.

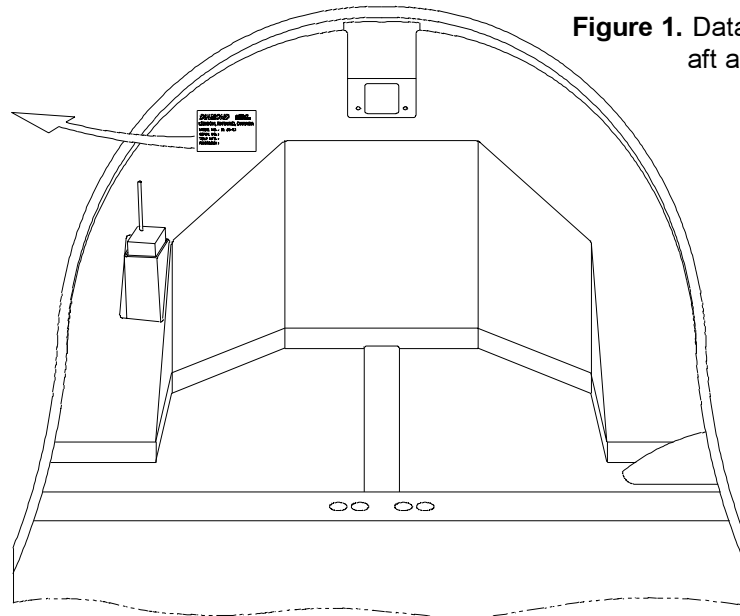
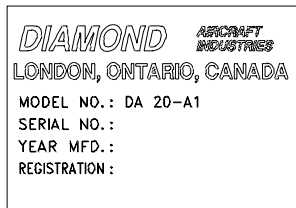


Figure 1. Data Plate Location (Looking aft at the B-bulkhead).

- 10.2.2 The data plate must be permanently installed (i.e. blind rivets) in the location shown in Figure 1, page 2.

10.3 Fuel Pipette

- 10.3.1 All German registered aircraft must be equipped with the fuel pipette (ref. P/N 20-1200-02-00).

10.4 Flight Manual

- 10.4.1 Verify, that the Flight Manual, Doc. No. DA202-D, contains the serial number specific data (Equipment Configuration, Weight and Balance data, Supplements).
- 10.4.2 Install German language Flight Manual, Doc. No. DA202-D, in the aircraft.

10. Accomplishment Instructions cont'd:

10.5 Required Equipment

- 10.5.1 **GENERAL.** It is the responsibility of the operator to ensure that the aircraft is equipped as required by applicable German regulations for its intended types of operation.
- 10.5.2 **BASIC EQUIPMENT.** The Flight Manual (ref. Doc. No. DA202-D) specifies the minimum equipment for safe operation of the DA-20 Katana.
- 10.5.3 **COM/NAV EQUIPMENT.** Additional required COM/NAV equipment is specified in the "Verordnung über die Flugsicherungs-ausrüstung der Luftfahrzeuge (FSAV)", depending on the type of operation (e.g.: VFR, CVFR, Flights "over the top").
- 10.5.4 **CABIN EQUIPMENT.** For TP3 operations, the aircraft must be equipped with a first aid kit, an emergency axe, and a fire extinguisher. This equipment must meet applicable regulations and must be installed in an approved manner.
